

Day by Day Itinerary

begins today as we depart on our flight to Israel. Meals and drive to Nazareth, home of the Holy Family. Visit Joseph's drinks served aloft.

HEM: Upon arrival in Tel Aviv we are welcomed by our Representative then drive to the Judean Hill Country for dinner renew their wedding vows. and overnight.

Overnight: Bethlehem (D)

NOVEMBER 3 DAY 3 - BETHLEHEM: This morning we visit the Church of the Nativity, situated above the traditional Grotto of Jesus birth. After touring the Manger, Grotto of St. Jerome, the Church of St. Catherine, we will visit the Milk Grotto. Later we head to the Shepherds' Field.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 4 DAY 4- JERUSALEM: Visit the gentle lush countryside of Ein Karem, the village where John the Baptist was born. Here we will visit the Church of the Visitation and the Church of St. John.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 5 DAY 5 - JERUSALEM / TIBERIAS: This morning, we leave Jerusalem and head to Tiberias. Drive along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, home of ancient Roman Procurators and the capitol city of the Roman Province of Palestine. Here, St. Peter preached and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Continue to the sparkling port city of Haifa. Ascend Mt. Carmel, home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha, for Mass. Stop at the Jordan River to renew our Baptismal Vows before continuing to Tiberias, our home for the next three nights.

Overnight: Nazareth/Tiberias (B, D)

NOVEMBER 1 DAY 1 - DEPART USA: Our Pilgrimage NOVEMBER 6 DAY 6 - TIBERIAS: Following breakfast, Workshop and the Grotto of the Annunciation. Following Mass and lunch in Nazareth, continue to Cana of Galilee, NOVEMBER 2 DAY 2 - ARRIVE TEL-AVIV / BETHLE- where our Lord performed the first miracle - changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here we will invite couples to

Overnight: Nazareth/Tiberias (B, D)

NOVEMBER 7 DAY 7 - TIBERIAS: Start the day at Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the loaves and fishes. Celebrate Mass on the shore of the Sea of Galilee where Jesus called his disciples and appeared after His Resurrection. Visit Capernaum, home of our Lord during His ministry, recall His many miracles and see the Synagogue where He taught. Then drive up to the Mt. of the Beatitudes for Mass and lunch near the site of the Sermon on the Mount. Conclude this day with a scenic boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

Overnight: Nazareth/Tiberias (B, D)

NOVEMBER 8 DAY 8 - TIBERIAS / JERUSALEM: This morning we depart Tiberias and travel to the summit of Mt. Tabor for Mass at the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus and enjoy a sweeping view of the beautiful Jezreel Valley. After driving south through the Jordan Valley, we will go up to Jerusalem for check-in at our hotel.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 9 DAY 9 – JERUSALEM: Begin the first day in Jerusalem with a visit to a large scale model of the city at the time of Jesus. Continue to the area of the ancient Jewish temple. Explore excavations of the temple environs, see the steps where Jesus preached and the evidence of the destruction of the Temple as Jesus foretold. See the Western Wall – the most sacred place in the world for Jews. Proceed to Mt. Zion where we will stand in the Upper Room, celebrating Mass very near where Jesus ate the Last supper with His disciples. Then we will visit the Dormition Abbey where we remember Mary "falling asleep" before her Assumption.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 10 DAY 10 – JERUSALEM: This morning drive to the top of the Mt. of Olives where we will visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer. We also visit the Chapel of the Ascension commemorating the Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven. Walk the Palm Sunday road to the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, where we will have Mass with a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Tomb of Mary. In the afternoon, we visit the Church of St. Peter in Galicantu at the place where Peter denied Jesus while He was awaiting trial before Sanhedrin. Return that evening to the Church of All Nations on the Garden of Gethsemane for a Holy Hour at the place where Jesus suffered the agony in the garden and was betrayed by Judas.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 11 DAY 11 – JERUSALEM: Today we will walk through the narrow cobble stone streets of the Old City, beginning with Mass at the Church of St. Anne, the birth-place of Mary, and viewing the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the infirm. Then follow Jesus on the Way of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher to visit Calvary, where Christ was crucified, the Stone of Anointing, and the empty Tomb of Our Savior which witnesses to our Easter faith in the Resurrection.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 12 DAY 12 – JERUSALEM: Drive to Bethany where Our Lord would stay in the home of His friends, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus during His visits to Jerusalem. This morning we will celebrate Mass near the place where Jesus restored Lazarus to life. After Mass, we will drive to Jericho, the oldest known city in the world. Take the tram up to the Mount of Temptation for lunch and a visit. Continue along the shores of the Dead Sea to Qumran to see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Then on to Ein Gedi for a swim in the salty, mineral laden and unsinkable waters of the Dead Sea.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 13 DAY 13 – JERUSALEM: This morning we drive to Samaria and stop at Nablus to visit Jacob's well (where Jesus met the Samaritan woman who offered Him a drink of water). Also visit the ancient royal city of Sebastia. Drive back to Bethlehem.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 14 DAY 14 – JERUSALEM: Today we will celebrate an early morning Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. The remainder of the day is free for personal activities. Late in the afternoon we will remember our Lord's appearance to His disciples on the road to Emmaus, and in the evening, we will enjoy a farewell Middle Eastern Dinner.

Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

NOVEMBER 15 DAY 15 -USA: Today we arrive home safely with unforgettable memories knowing that we have walked in the footsteps of Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION: To make your reservation simply complete the enclosed registration form and submit along with \$400 payment (mailed to the address shown on the bottom of the registration form). You will receive an invoice, and further information by mail, within two weeks after receipt of your deposit.

Please submit your registration form early, as all space is available on a first-come basis. Registrations are processed in the order they are received by Holy Land Travel Center.

Price is based on a minimum of 30 fully paying passengers in the group. *Optional travel protection plan will be added separately on your invoice*. A valid passport is required for USA citizens. No visa is required for USA citizens. Please see 'Registration Form' and Terms & Conditions for more details.

Terms and Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$400 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. A second payment of \$1499 is required on or before 8/1/2011. Final payment is due 9/15/2011. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 60 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$100 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$200 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/ or penalties assessed by airlines.
- 3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$300 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/ or penalties assessed by airlines, hotels, or other suppliers of travel services (up to the total cost of the tour;
- 4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOM-MENDED): Passenger Travel protection program is administered by Travel Guard. This program is available through HLTC and is strongly recommended. Holy Land Travel center, is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. Medical coverage during your stay in the Holy Land is included in your tour price. Travel Protection plan cannot be purchased after full payment has been made. All Protection Plan fees are non-refundable. (\$139)

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well being. The HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$660.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily. All other beverages are extra.

TIPPING: The price of the tour includes tips and gratuities.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing nonrefundable, non-amenable tickets for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from same. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

BAGGAGE: The passenger is allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

Minimum number of paying pasengers is 30.
