COMMITTEE REPORTS

Erik (for Lorraine): ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

ACA \$61,537.41 from 344 families, average donation is \$178.79. This total includes an estimate for tithing families of \$8,550, which will be finalized and paid to the Diocese around October 10, 2017. If all pledges are paid up by the end of the year, we will receive \$11,537.41 back from the Diocese. Historically, our pledge fulfillment rate is over 99%. We are still receiving responses from our second letter.

- 2. Scrip sales on the plaza after all Masses on the weekends are switching to sales every other week during July and August.

Diana: VEHICLE DONATION PROGRAM

The current vehicle donation Program has received a grand total of \$70,422 from 110 vehicle donations.

This year has brought in four more donations so far, totaling \$2,720.00.

Chris: **STEWARDSHIP**

Planned Giving/Towers of Faith – We received one bequest for \$10,000 and one bequest distribution has been pending for 8-9 months. Chris has been in contact with the attorney to expedite this distribution for the current fiscal year. Estimated amount to be \$30,000 - \$35,000.

Stewardship – Moving along with the monthly four square bulletin insert highlighting most current opportunities at STM.

Gala raised \$44,000. 250 families participated. Gala wrap meeting was June 13. Looking for new ideas for next year. It is time to change out the Gala and try something new and uplifting. Ideas such as concert, dinner/dance, or casino night. Maybe raffle 1 – 3 large ticket items such as a new car or cruise at \$100 per ticket. Check with our Knights of Columbus if they are doing a Casino Night. If not, Chris and Diana Diaz will connect for ideas on that. Next year's event will be held on Friday, April 27, 2018.

We are looking for help with Treasures as John Murphy is going to be stepping back after this year. A new parishioner has expressed interest in this ministry, so this is a possibility for John to train someone to take over next year.
