Going Electronic

This issue of Liturgical Ministers Update marks the first time we have sent out this newsletter and the accompanying scheduling materials to the Liturgical Ministers of the Parish electronically.

Many of you have asked why we continued to mail the schedule each quarter. The short answer is that we had to mail a certain number of the schedules to those who do not have email addresses, and to send it to all of us using "bulk" mail rates was in fact cheaper than sending it to those without email addresses. The numbers have changed.

Beginning this quarter, those who have asked the Parish to use their email address for communications will receive their Update electronically. Those without email, or those who have asked the Parish not to use their email, have been sent a postcard inviting them to pick up their schedule during Parish office hours.

We will still be posting the schedule on the Parish website at www.stmoside.org, but the contact information also found in the Update will only be available in the packet sent electronically or picked up.

If you have any suggestions for other improvements in the system, let me know. Technology is our friend, even if it takes some time to apply it to our needs.

We are taking advantage of this great stewardship opportunity available through the use of email, as it allows us to divert the printing and postage monies into other areas in the ministry and mission of St. Thomas More Parish.

Scheduling

Another electronic technology that has seen ongoing improvement is our scheduling program. It is vital that you fill your cards out **completely** before turning them in. The program now allows our volunteer data-entry person (God bless her!) to input more of the information, making it more accurate and faster!

SUMMER

From My Desk to Your Ministry SOME ISSUES AND CONCERNS...

In a Liturgy Committee meeting that I attended recently, a distinction was made in reference to “good liturgy” and “great liturgy.”

If I may use a musical analogy: Good choirs sing all the notes on the page with technical skill and with great energy; Great choirs master the technical requirements and work beyond them to allow the music to speak to them and, through them, to their audience as well.

Good liturgy facilitates our speaking to God. Great liturgy allows God to speak to us without anything to distract us.

Part of the responsibility for great liturgy lies in our hands, and it is the details that are key. We must master the nuances of our ministries so they become effortless, allowing us to put the details outside of our consciousness thus allowing God to work in us and through us.

I appreciate all that you do, and I know that you are willing to do your utmost to continue your liturgical ministry with the highest regard for God’s work on earth and the saving grace he has given us in his son, Jesus.

At St. Thomas More, we have great liturgy in many respects. Here are one or two “details” for us to work on in the next few months that will allow our liturgy to continue in this “great” direction.

Eucharistic Ministers

It is clear that your devotion to the Eucharist is tremendous as you serve the Body and Blood of our Lord to the members of this Parish.

A first concern

Some would like clarification on how the vessels (patens and chalices) are to be purified and cleansed after every Mass.

Moving toward “great”

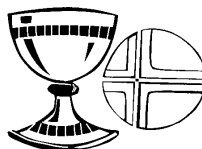
Nothing begins until after the liturgy is completed, that is, after the recessional song is finished.

Four people are assigned to purify and cleanse the vessels after every Mass, specifically the ministers who serve the Body.

Purifying the patens requires lightly brushing all the remaining Precious Body into the corporal that was on the altar, and then eating the crumbs from the corporal so that there are no pieces remaining. Then the patens are washed with a minimum of soap and water.

Purifying the chalices involves pouring a small amount of water into them, swirling the water to gather the residual Precious Blood, and then drinking the mixture. This is done before washing the chalices with a minimum of soap and water.

If you feel unable to serve after Mass in this capacity, please let me know and I will make sure only to schedule you to serve the Precious Blood.



A second concern

In fairness, the Church has not been receiving the Eucharist under both species (Body and Blood) for very long.

That said, are you doing your utmost to invite those you are serving to partake the Precious Body AND the Precious Blood?

Moving toward “great”

In all four Eucharistic Prayers that the Presider uses from the Sacramentary he shares Jesus’ words that invite us to partake of his Eucharistic gift:

“Take this, all of you, and eat it.”

“Take this, all of you, and drink from it.”

We, on the other hand, have to say it silently, with our posture our gesture, and our eyes.

It’s easy when we offer the host because the congregation goes to the host first. But then what?

Are we actively inviting the person who has eaten the host to come to us so that he or she might finish the holy meal?

Please understand that I am not speaking of when we have someone in front of us, drinking from our chalice. Rather, what are we doing when no one is in front of us? Communing with God’s presence? Staring into space?

Instead, let us latch on to that next person in line for the holy banquet and explicitly invite them to share in this holy mystery.

Altar Servers

The training that has been taking place recently has provided a visible improvement in the consistency of our service at the altar. Thank you, Tilly!

A concern

Sometimes, it seems easier to put on our "formal faces" when we serve at or around the altar than when we are in our chairs or in procession.

Moving toward "great"

When Moses approached the burning bush, God had to remind him that the ground he was walking on was holy, because God was present.

God is present whenever the assembly meets to worship him, and we must remember that our whole self must be God-centered as we serve at Mass.

Your posture, your appearance, your demeanor, and your apparel all demonstrate your attitude while you serve. Are you carrying the processional cross in a manner worthy of the figure hanging on it? Are you carrying the processional candles with the reverence due the cross you are escorting? Does your sitting in the "pews" or your walking to and from the credence table show the respect you have for the Savior who we worship this day?



Hospitality

No friendlier Parish. Not a bad title offered by many of our visitors and newcomers. You are the on front line in this effort.

A concern

Sometimes, our coverage of the entire room is not complete.

Moving toward "great"

Except for the team leader (see below), it does not matter which numbered hospitality minister serves at which position. The importance lies in making sure all the areas are covered.

Before Mass begins, I expect to see three ministers on the plaza, widely separated to cover all approaches to the building and not chatting with each other. I often see people entering through the northern door without a worship aid in hand. That they can "sneak in" means we are missing our opportunity to greet them.

The fourth minister should be stationed by the doorway into the elevator lobby, facing toward the lobby.

The team leader should be inside the building, helping those who may be visiting to find seats, and otherwise assisting those who appear lost or in need, finding and coaching the gift bearers, and otherwise keeping an eye on the congregation.

Finally, I expect every person who walks into the church to be greeted and given a worship aid, even if they are ten or more minutes late. Are you keeping an eye on the elevator lobby entrance?

Readers

Frequently, I receive comments from visitors as to the quality of the readers in this Parish. They remark on your clarity, strength, and clear purpose as it contrasts with other parishes they have visited or they call home.

A concern

Sometimes, our proclamation of God's word seems overly focused on the words in between the phrases, "A reading from . . ." and "The word of the Lord."

Moving toward "great"

From the time you stand up to walk to the ambo to the moment you sit in your seat, you are in fact proclaiming God's word to his people. How we walk to and from the ambo, how we turn the pages of the Lectionary, how we hold ourselves (that is, our posture), and how we interact with the people are all part of our proclamation in that they display for the entire assembly how we show our respect for God and his word.

The one that has been bothering me most of late . . . Do you listen to the assembly, in conversation with them, waiting for them to respond with "Thanks be to God" before you turn the page or close the Lectionary? Not waiting for the response after you say, "The word of the Lord" is like the bank teller who asks, "How are you?" without really meaning it.



Sacristans

This summer will be a time of transition for the sacristans, with most of our teens leaving to embark on a new part of their lives' journeys.

A concern

In the past, when we have had transitional times, some of those leaving have fallen into less-than-utmost habits. When I was in high school we called it "senioritis."

Moving toward "great"

Communication will be our key this summer as we train our new sacristans and bid adieu to those who are leaving us.

If you are leaving before August 31, make sure you find someone to cover your Masses, or contact me if you cannot find anyone to do so.

More important certainly, I expect you to make sure that your leaving does not diminish your sense of service to the liturgy and to the Parish. Your part, the details that you attend to, are vitally important to the quality of the liturgy at St. Thomas More, attending to them faithfully at the end of your service will hold you in good stead in your future endeavors.
