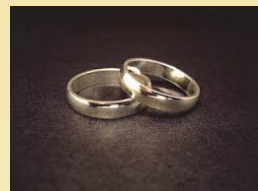

## THE JESUS NUT

As they traveled with Jesus—who went about doing good, preaching the gospel of forgiveness and salvation, and bringing wholeness and holiness to all who believed—the disciples were to learn that faith and religion are more than adherence to a set of rules or laws, however challenging and demanding those may be. Rather, they found that faith and religion are rooted in a personal relationship that God has initiated with each of us (and with all of us) in Jesus Christ.

This was not unknown to the people of Israel, who were repeatedly assured throughout their long and checkered history, “You are my people; I am your God!” But the reality of their relationship with God was sometimes obscured by a misdirected obsession with law, ritual purity, and righteousness. When Jesus, God’s Word and Wisdom, came to live and move among us, he tried to redirect the minds and hearts of his contemporaries so that they might focus on God and on their relationship with God, which was to inspire their every thought, motivate their every action, and guide their growth in becoming holy and loving, as God is. That relationship was also to be the norm by which every other relationship would be conducted, the source of their initiation and growth.

The essential quality of their relationship with Jesus became clearer the more the disciples traveled in his company. The challenges inherent in that relationship also became more compelling. As is reflected in the Gospels for this month, Jesus did not set aside the law as a God-given guide; rather, he urged his own to go far beyond the letter of the law, its limitations and restraints, to embrace and fulfill the spirit of the law, which was boundless.

### scripture themes for October

Jesus did not seek a loophole to justify divorce; he bid his own to remember and reverence the God-given gift of marriage and the purpose for which it was created (Oct 4). When asked about the requisites for gaining eternal life, Jesus went beyond the commandments and invited believers to divest themselves of their base of security (“Go, sell what you have, give to the poor”) so as to make him and his will their way of life (Oct 11). Jesus challenged those who wanted to share in his greatness and authority, to find their greatness and their very selves in the authentic and ongoing service of all others (Oct 18).

On October 25, and through the experience of the blind Bartimaeus, we will find ourselves coming to Jesus with a similar request: “I want to see!” Yes, Lord, I want to see and understand that your ways and your will are often beyond my grasp. I do not think as you do. I do not see as you do. I do not love as you do—and yet I want to. Jesus’ response to us is the same as it was to the blind son of Timaeus: “Your faith has saved you.” Once he saw, Bartimaeus followed Jesus on the way. He did not have answers to all life’s questions. He only knew that he had to follow Jesus.

In the same way, we are gradually to cultivate a keener clarity in our vision and understanding of who Jesus is and who we are to be because of him. This quality of growth is made possible if our lives, our energies, our hopes and desires are centered in Jesus. Like thirsty people who return to a water source every day and hungry people who need daily bread, we return to Jesus again and again as the source of our life and our reason for being.

A dear friend of mine, a man of the word and a true servant of God’s

people, tells a story that illustrates this point well. Adapted from a story first told by Carolyn Moran (*The Nut That Saved Our Marriage*, 1977), this tale grew out of a conversation that Carolyn and her husband had with their son Mike, a Navy helicopter pilot. Mike’s father began asking about the helicopter his son flew. “You know, Dad,” Mike said, “as complicated as a helicopter is, its whirling rotor is held in place by a single hexagon nut. Do you know what they call that nut?” Both parents shrugged. His mom said, “I give up. What do they call the single nut that holds it all together?” Mike smiled and said, “They call it the Jesus nut.”

Just as all the complex workings of the helicopter hinged on the presence of that one single hexagon nut, so does the well-being, the faith, the growth, and the integrity of each believer depend upon the centrality of the presence of Jesus in his or her life. At the center of all creation, at the center of God’s plan of salvation, at the very center of all revelation, Jesus is.

Before he concluded the very last book of the Christian scriptures, the author of Revelation left each of us with an eloquent reminder of the necessary and unique importance of Jesus: “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End” (22:13). He is our center, our source, our sustenance, our fulfillment. Amen.

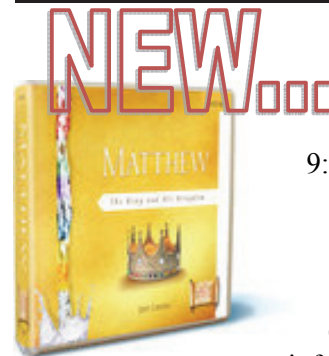

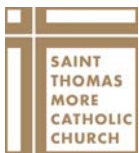

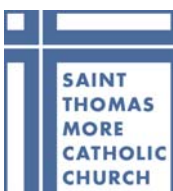
